Palette: DeoArt Americana Acrylic

Lamp Black, Warm White, Fawn, Burnt Sienna, Golden Straw, Hauser Lt Green, Avocado
Asphaltum, Deep Burgundy

Brushes: Royal

Series 150 RG #8 flat

Series 595 #0 liner

Series 6150-S #4 flat

Short length White Bristle Stencil R1112 $\frac{1}{4}$ ", $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Supplies:

Basic painting supplies

Card stock paper-brown bag color

String for hanging

Optional: spray sealer

Scissors

Hole punch

Preparation: Cut tags from card stock. Punch hole using the hole punch.

Trace on basic lines.

Painting Instructions:

Sheep: No base coating with the brown paper. Shade with Burnt Sienna. Stipple with Warm White. Paint tail, head, ears and legs with Lamp Black. Dot eyes with warm White. Paint cross hatching on the cheeks with Warm White using the liner brush. Paint Squiggle line with Lamp Black.

Heart: paint with Deep Burgundy. Out line with Lamp Black.

Pineapple, moon and star: basecoat with Golden Straw. Shade with Burnt Sienna. Highlight with Warm White. Paint lines on pineapple and fence with Asphaltum. Paint leaves with Avocado. Highlight with Hauser Lt Green.

Paint fence wire with Warm White.

Outline with Lamp Black. Paint cluster dots in the sky with Fawn and Asphaltum.

Paint all the squiggles lines around the edges with Lamp Black. Shade around the edge and around each design with Asphaltum. I shaded several times, letting the paint dry in between shadings. This gives it a darker, older look.

Basecoat the grass with Avocado.

If paper curls, after drying, place a heavy book on tags, this will flatten them out. Hang with string. Spray with sealer (optional). Enjoy and have fun. These are fast and easy.
