Palette: Deco Art Americana Acrylic  
Black, Cinnamon Drop, Green Tea, Plantation Pine, Lt Buttermilk  
Deco Art Neons Fiery Red  
Deco Art Matte Spray Sealer

Brushes: Artist Club 800-845-6507  
¼", ½" angular  
#6, #8 flat  
10/0 liner  
BRSH002 Dome Brush Set: Creative Arts Lifestyles

Additional Supplies:  
E6000 glue, Pin back

Wood cutting:  
Cut pin from 1/8" wood. Sand and remove dust.

Painting instructions:  
Basecoat the heart with Black. But not the ribbon. Let dry. Lightly sand for a smooth surface. Using one of the dome brushes (to fit surface) stipple over the black with Cinnamon Drop. You will need to do several coats, be sure to let paint dry in between coats. Once you have built up the red, stipple with Fiery Red to highlight. Shade around the edge with Black. Paint the dots with Lt Buttermilk.  
Paint the ribbon with Green Tea. Shade with Plantation Pine. Highlight with Lt Buttermilk.  
Paint the letters Black and dot the letters. Let dry.

I painted the back Black. Let dry. Glue the pin onto the back with E6000 glue.
