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Palette: DecoArt Americana

Black, White, Antique White, Santa Red, Bittersweet, Chocolate, Heritage Brick, Persimmon Orange
DecoArt Neons Fiery Red
DecoArt Matte Spray

Brushes: Artist Club 800-845-6507

18/0 liner
¼" Angular
#1, #4, #6 Shader
¼" stippler

Additional Supplies:

Basic painting supplies	Tracing paper
Stylus	Scissor
Card Board	Pipe cleaner
Instant Coffee	Pin back
Hot glue gun and stick	

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Cutting Instructions:

Trace basic lines onto card board. Cut out with scissors.

Antlers:

Mix instant coffee with water to a dark color (very strong coffee) you will only need ¼ cup. Dip pipe cleaner into coffee mixture. Do not wring out. I place mine on a rack in my sink to dry.

Once dried, cut off about 1 ½" off each end. Add back to the end by twisting. Set aside.

Painting Instructions:

Base coat hat with Black. Basecoat hat band with Antique White. Paint the stripes with Santa Red. Shade Antique White and Santa Red with Bittersweet Chocolate. Dry brush White on the Antique White. Dry brush Fiery Red on the Santa Red. Dabble snow and paint twinkle on hat with White.

Face: Stipple with Antique White. Let dry. Stipple again with White. Shade under hat and around the face with Bittersweet Chocolate. Dry brush the cheeks with Heritage Brick.

Paint the ball on nose with Santa Red. Highlight with Fiery Red, then a little White.

Paint the carrot nose with Persimmon. Shade with Bittersweet Chocolate. Highlight with Antique White.

Paint eyes and details on face with Black. Highlight eyes and cheeks with White. Let dry.

Assembling: Hot glue pipe cleaner to the back and the pin. Spray with sealer. Optional: add glitter.
